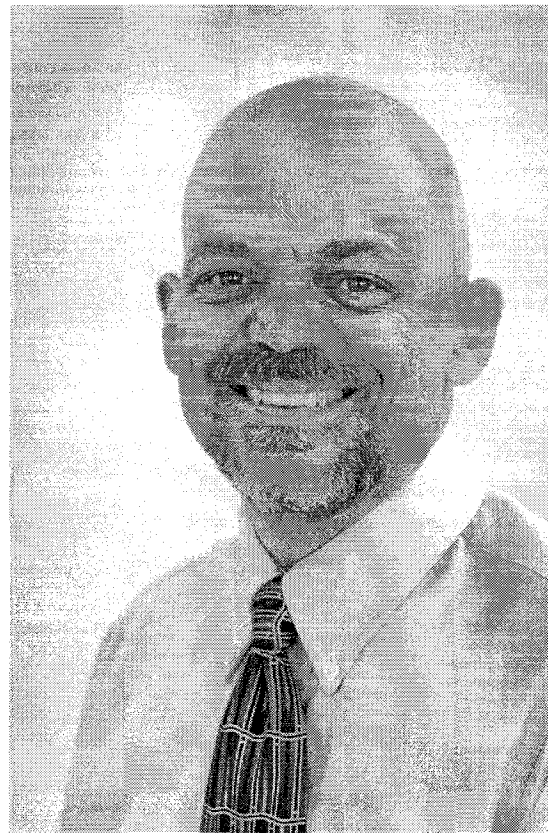


What Does It Mean to Live a *Sacramental Life?*
